Access to Changing rooms	Multiple people trying to access	No	Red	Access to changing rooms denied, access for managers and club officials only and a maximum of 2 persons in this area at any one time. Toilets and changing rooms to be separated with a physical barrier.	Green	
Access to toilets, hand sanitising and washing facilities	Yes, if supervision required and multiple people requiring their use	Yes	Amber	Signs and limited access to facilities sign posted, max of one person in the toilets at any one time. A barrier to separate changing room and toilet facilities will be in place.	Amber

Track & Trace	People not completing form	No	Red	A greeter will meet all site visitors at the main gate and record their contact details on arrival.  Dog walkers using the site will be advised to maintain social distancing via a sign attached to the front gate.	Amber	
Personal Property and rubbish	No	No	Green	All people will be told to take all their own rubbish and personal items when leaving site.	Green	
Medical equipment and water bottles	If player is treated by someone outside of their bubble then risk is a factor	No	Amber	First aiders are aware that only significant issues will be attended to, otherwise they will not approach players. All players will have their own bottle.	Green	
Indoor areas, for example tea hut and spectator stand	Influx of supporters	Yes	Amber	All plans are in place for social distancing, signs, stickers and restrictions on numbers allowed to enter the indoor areas. Only the person operating the operating tea hut will be allowed in.	Green	
Pitch access and Children using goals	Volume of children and touchpoints of nets and goals, increasing this risk of transfer to players	No	Green	Pitch is fully enclosed and signs are in place advising that access to the pitch is restricted. Any children will be asked to leave the site whilst it is being used for football. Linesman's flags will be sanitised.	Green	
Exit of ground	Blocked access	No	Amber	Car park access will allow easy exit of the ground.	Green
